Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Today, rain continuing across the north and west of Scotland, edging into Northern Ireland. Elsewhere, bright spells in some eastern parts but mostly cloudy with brisk southwesterly winds bringing patchy drizzle to exposed hills in the west. Mostly mild.
Tonight, clearing skies behind the rain mean icy stretches developing in Northern Ireland and western Scotland. Elsewhere, mostly cloudy, mild, breezy with rain in places, heaviest and most persistent across Scotland, Wales and western England.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Feeling colder with a good deal of cloud and outbreaks of rain for most, some sleet and snow on hills, especially in the north and west.
