

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Early sharp frost, then largely dry and sunny. However freezing fog patches, mainly across central England and Northern Ireland, may locally persist. Wintry showers across northeast England and northern Scotland, some heavy. Overnight rain quickly reaching southwest England and then spreading northeast, turning to snow inland. Significant snowfall will occur, especially across Wales and the Midlands. Snow showers eastern Scotland.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday snow, mainly light, over northern England, southwest Scotland, and Northern Ireland. Heavy rain showers across southwest Britain. Wintry showers persisting eastern Scotland. Friday sleet or snow across southern Scotland and northern England, rain or showers for many other places.
