Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a rather chilly start Wednesday will be dry with light winds and plenty of warm sunshine across most of the UK. It will be cloudy and cooler across northern Scotland with some patchy rain. Breezy for English Channel coasts. Largely dry and clear overnight with a patchy frost possible. Cloud and some showers possible in the southwest by dawn.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Many central and northern areas will stay dry with sunny spells on Thursday. Locally heavy showery rain in the southwest will move north and may become more widespread across southern parts overnight. Rain and thundery showers moving north on Friday.
