

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It'll be a cloudy start in the east, with some outbreaks of drizzle, as well as hill snow over Scotland. However, further west it'll be chillier with frost, fog and icy patches. Brighter spells will develop later in the day for many, although showers will push into the west, turning heavy at times, possibly with some hail and thunder.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

A mostly cloudy day on Wednesday with outbreaks of light rain in the east. Brighter spells are likely further west, and it'll be mostly dry, barring the odd shower. It'll turn colder on Thursday with some snow showers in the east.
