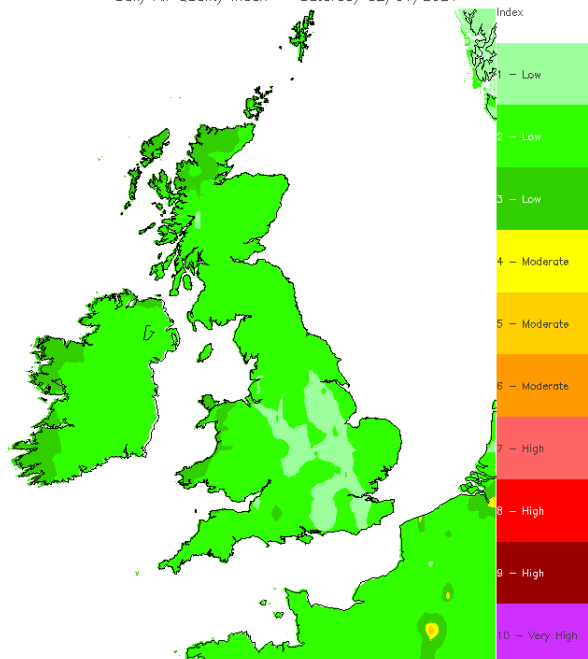
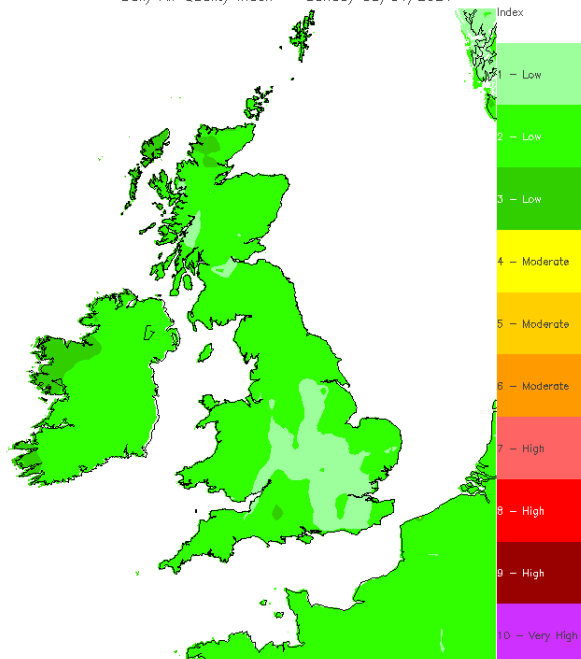


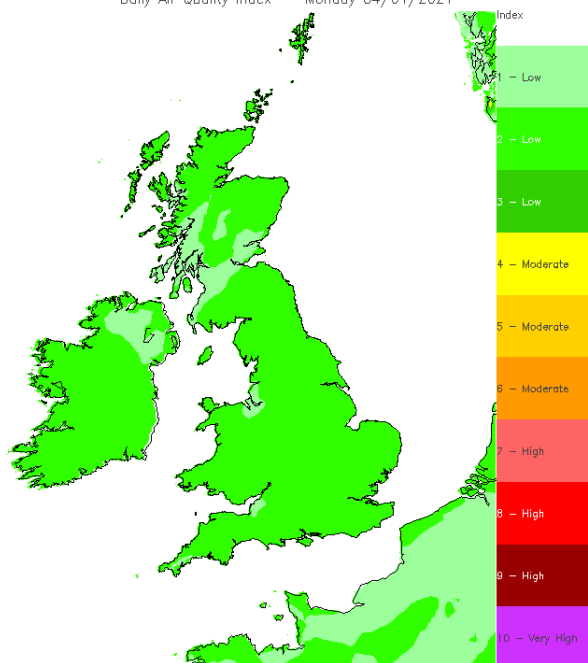
Daily Air Quality Index — Saturday 02/01/2021



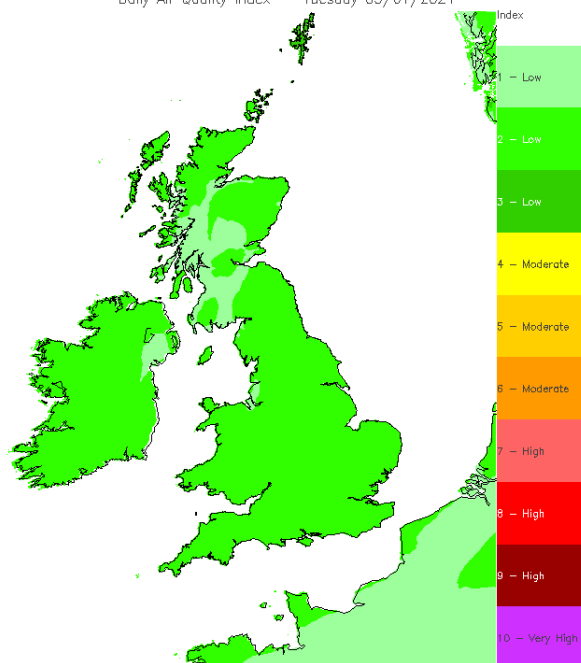
Daily Air Quality Index — Sunday 03/01/2021



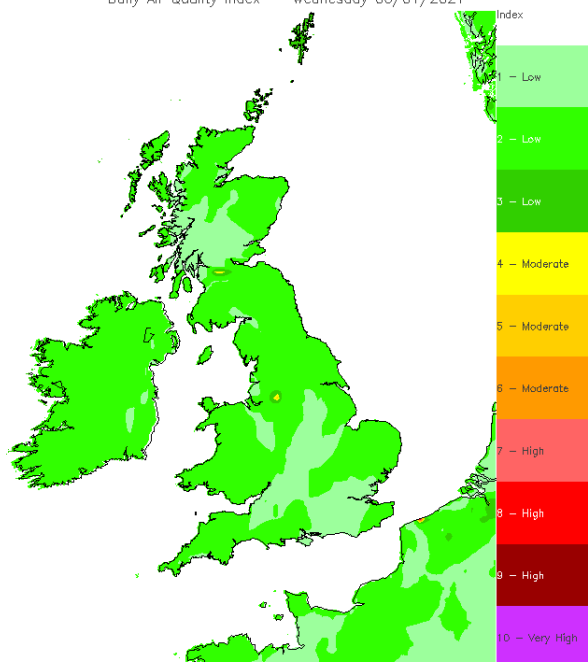
Daily Air Quality Index — Monday 04/01/2021

Today: Largely dry with sunny spells for many. Some showers affecting coastal regions, where possibly wintry, especially as they move inland. Staying cold. Air pollution levels will remain Low during Saturday.

Tomorrow: Rather cloudy, with occasional bright or sunny spells in the west. Frequent and heavy showers in the east, turning wintry on hills. Air pollution levels will remain Low during Sunday.

Outlook: The cold weather continues throughout, with further wintry showers in the south and east, where windier. Drier elsewhere. Air pollution levels should remain Low, with a few isolated Moderate areas on Wednesday.
