Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Monday: In the north: a day of sunny intervals and showers, mainly in west, but these showers merging to bring some longer spells of rain in N.Ireland and SW Scotland later. Over England/Wales, mostly dry with sunny spells developing after a rather cloudy misty start. Risk of isolated torrential thunderstorms in southeast England/East Anglia, where it will stay hot and humid. Feeling fresher elsewhere.  
Monday night:-Scotland/Northern Ireland: outbreaks of rain in N.Ireland, SW Scotland spreading eastwards for a time. England and Wales: mostly dry although drizzly in N England/NW Wales.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Largely dry and fine in the south with spells of very warm sunshine. Cloudier in the northwest with rain or showers.
