Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Early rain will clear northern Scotland, then sunny intervals and showers for much of the UK. Some heavy and thundery showers are possible across central and southern Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England, however lighter elsewhere. Mainly dry across southern England. Temperatures generally around normal, though feeling cool at times in the north.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Further showers on Monday, mainly across central and eastern England, and eastern Scotland. More persistent rain will affect northwest Scotland later. Rain for many western areas on Tuesday, but mainly dry across eastern England throughout the day. Feeling a little warmer for most places on Monday.
