Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain and strong winds will spread across western areas this morning and extend to eastern parts this afternoon. Most of the rain will be in the west especially over higher ground. Gales likely on western coasts and hills. Tonight, rain will clear eastwards, squally rain and hail showers following to western areas.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

More wet and very windy weather will spread from the west on Monday after a bright start with sunny spells. Gales or severe gales likely in the west. Rain will clear eastwards overnight to give a bright day Tuesday with sunny intervals and scattered showers.
