

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 27 Aug 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain across some northern areas will clear away eastwards, leaving a little drizzle across some western hills. Otherwise, a generally cloudy, but warm day, though a few bright or sunny intervals are possible, mainly in the east. Tonight, most places dry, cloudy and warm, but further rain will spread to much of Scotland.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain across Scotland will clear Thursday morning. Otherwise most places will have dry days, but with rather a lot of cloud. However, there is an increasing likelihood of some sunshine developing, especially in the south and east, and here it will become very warm.
