

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most places will be dry with sunny spells, although it will be cloudy with some rain in the far northwest of Scotland. Cloud is likely across central and eastern parts of England too, with an isolated shower possible. It will be dry, clear and frosty in northern and western Britain overnight, but rain will spread to southeastern England by morning.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Cold, wet and windy weather will extend across southern areas on Sunday. Much of Scotland and Northern Ireland will be sunny and warm but eastern England will be cloudy. Scattered showers are expected on Monday with northwestern Britain mainly fine.
