

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Starting mainly dry and chilly, with southern Britain remaining largely dry and bright throughout. Elsewhere, wet and windy weather will soon push in from the west, with the rain will occasionally turning heavy, especially over northwestern UK, before improving by dusk. Overnight, further rain will move in to affect all but southern Britain, with strong southwesterly winds countrywide.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday continuing largely wet and windy, with persistent rain over western Britain and with gales possible in the exposed northwest. By Wednesday, becoming drier and warmer from the south, with rain and brisk winds becoming increasingly confined to the north.
