Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

It will be a cloudy and windy day across the UK with strong southwesterly winds giving occasional gales in the north and west. Heavy rain is expected to affect parts of Scotland, northwest England and Northern Ireland, perhaps giving some hill snow in the far north of Scotland. Elsewhere, outbreaks of drizzly rain are expected through the day.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Unsettled conditions will continue with strong southwesterly winds and outbreaks of rain, which may be heavy at times, especially over western hills. Mild in most parts, although it will turn colder across Scotland at times, with occasional wintry showers and sunny spells.
