Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Northern Ireland, central and western Scotland will be dry with some
sunshine and feel pleasantly warm. Eastern Scotland however, will be
damp and misty and quite cool. Much of England and Wales will start
damp and misty, and areas near the North Sea coast are likely to
remain grey and chilly for much of the day. However, most places
should have warm sunny spells developing, but with scattered heavy
showers, especially for central and southern areas.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Most places will be dry and warm with some sunshine on Saturday,
though some rain will edge southwards across Scotland and Northern
Ireland. During Sunday, this rain will edge southeastwards across
England and Wales with clearer weather following to the north and
west.
