Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Fog in southern parts will soon clear, bringing sunny periods and scattered heavy showers. Northern parts will stay cloudy with showery rain, some heavy, perhaps thundery. Cloud and patchy rain in Northern Ireland, spreading into southwestern parts. Very warm and muggy in the southeast, temperatures otherwise near normal. Showers dying out in southern parts tonight, fog patches forming later. Northern parts mostly cloudy with outbreaks of rain, although many western and southern parts should become dry, many eastern and central parts becoming overcast and misty. Patchy rain may affect Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Remaining unsettled with showers or longer outbreaks of rain.
