Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Less windy today with sunny spells, many central and eastern areas staying dry, while scattered showers continue to affect western parts. However, showers across northern and western Scotland will be heavy and frequent, some with hail and thunder. Temperatures mostly near normal  
Tonight, showers will die away with most areas dry and clear for a time although cloud will increase from the west, with rain spreading to western parts later.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Continuing unsettled and sometimes windy with further rain at times, but some brighter, showery spells as well. Gales are likely in exposed parts, especially the far north on Sunday.
