

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 02 Feb 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sleet and snow showers will affect northern and western areas this morning, with more persistent rain spreading in this afternoon. Eastern parts should be largely dry with some sunshine. It will feel cold with a freshening southwesterly wind. Generally cloudy and windy with occasional rain tonight, most persistent across the northwest. Driest in the southeast.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Rain in the west initially will only slowly push east during Sunday, with some heavy rain and coastal gales likely. Eastern England may stay dry until evening. Sunny spells and scattered showers will follow to western parts on Sunday, becoming widespread on Monday.
