Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Blustery showers, some heavy and thundery, will affect many parts at first but gradually they should die away in most areas as sunny spells develop but showers will linger in the north. Strong to gale force winds will ease in the south but will continue in the north. Temperatures should be similar to Sunday's values. Tonight most parts will be dry but rain will move into the far northwest where it will be windy.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Rain affecting Scotland and Northern Ireland at times but dry in England and Wales with bright or sunny spells developing. Warm generally.
