

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Today will be very windy across parts of Scotland, with further rain, sleet and snow showers. Elsewhere, it will be much drier and brighter than Christmas Day, although feeling colder too, with temperatures near normal. Overnight, outbreaks of rain will gradually clear northern parts of the UK. Otherwise, a chilly night further south, with frost and occasional fog patches possible.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be largely dry, with plenty of sunshine. Parts of England and Wales will see a frosty and perhaps foggy start on Wednesday, followed by another fine day, whereas north-western counties will see a milder but more unsettled day.
