Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a very cold, frosty start, with freezing fog patches, much of England and Wales will have a dry, cold and bright day, although turning somewhat milder and windier in the far north and west. For Northern Ireland and Scotland it will be mild and very windy, with rain at times, the heaviest rain over western Scotland.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Wet and windy weather spreading southwards to much of northern England and North Wales on Sunday, while staying dry and windy to the south and east. On Monday, wet and windy in the south, with sunshine and showers in the north.
