

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 12 Jan 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Fog patches clearing quickly this morning to leave a largely dry and bright day in eastern Britain. Cloud and wind will continue spreading from the west bringing rain later, although not reaching eastern areas until this evening. Rain will continue eastwards overnight, clearing during the early hours with scattered showers following from the west. Patchy frost is possible.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Scattered showers will affect southern and western parts of the UK on Monday, with a spell of more persistent rain during the afternoon, reaching eastern areas in the evening. It will be a dry and largely sunny day for most on Tuesday.
