

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will become increasingly cloudy across many eastern parts of England, with outbreaks of rain developing, as well as an increasing northerly wind. These conditions will spread slowly west, but otherwise it will be fine and dry with good spells of sunshine, although there will be some fog around to start, and this is likely to re-form overnight.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

England and Wales will become increasingly cloudy into next week. Most places will remain dry, although the odd spot of drizzle cannot be ruled out. For Northern Ireland and Scotland it will remain fine and settled, although it will be chilly overnight.
