

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A fine, though breezy, start for many with sunny spells. Showery rain mainly across Northern Ireland at first will gradually spread northeastwards into Scotland, whilst cloud increases to bring scattered showery outbreaks across England and Wales. Heavier showers slowly clearing overnight, becoming largely confined to northeast Scotland by dawn. Generally cloudy, damp and mild elsewhere with winds falling light.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Often cloudy at first Thursday, though soon brightening up with plenty of sunny weather, and only isolated showers developing. Feeling warmer than of late with mainly light winds. Largely fine on Friday, with further warm sunshine and generally isolated showers.
