Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Much of England and Wales will start dry. However, organised rain, locally heavy, accompanied by gale force winds across many northwestern areas will spread southeastwards. Sunnier skies will follow, reaching all but southeast England by dusk. Many places will then be dry and less windy, but blustery showers are likely in the northwest.

Tonight, rain in the southeast will move away, then many places will be dry and clear with a touch of frost. However, showers and strong winds in the north will spread to some western areas later.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Unsettled and very windy with rain or showers in all areas, but it should be generally mild.
