Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will remain mostly cloudy, with light rain at times in the west and in parts of the east at first, tending to be more persistent in western Scotland. There will be some brighter spells, mainly in sheltered southern and eastern parts. Stronger winds and heavier rain will spread into the far northwest later.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Periods of rain, sometimes heavy, particularly in the northwest, will be interspersed with clearer spells and blustery showers, themselves heavy at times. Hill snow is likely in Scotland during Saturday. It will be windy with gales in many areas, especially in the north.
