

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 1945 on Saturday 21 Feb 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A dry start for most, before rain, locally heavy, spreads east. Where this meets the cold air, this will bring some snow for a time across northern parts, with some accumulations possible, especially across hills. Winds will also strengthen, with coastal gales developing in the west. Rain will clear eastwards during the evening, with showers following.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A cold and windy couple of days, with gales, locally severe, and blustery showers. These showers are likely to be wintry, especially over higher ground and in the north where some significant accumulations are likely. These showers will then gradually ease during Tuesday.
