Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Frequent heavy and blustery showers across northwest Britain, these wintry over hills, and occasionally to lower levels. Southern Britain will be rather cloudy with occasional showers. Becoming clear and cold overnight across southern Britain, but showers continuing across northern and western Britain, especially towards coasts, giving a covering of snow especially in parts of western Scotland and Northwest England.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Heavy wintry showers across northwest UK on Monday, with further snow accumulations possible in places. Bright with a few showers elsewhere. Sunny spells and showers continuing into Tuesday but the showers tending to turn back to rain at lower levels. Cold.
