Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
After a chilly start any early patches of fog will soon disperse leaving most places with a dry and bright day with sunny spells. However, northwestern Scotland will have cloudier skies with outbreaks of rain. Tonight it will be generally dry with variable amounts of cloud.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday thickening cloud will spread a band of rain in from the west, although the rain will not reach many eastern areas until after dusk. The rain will clear away into the North Sea overnight leaving a day of sunshine and showers on Tuesday, although further rain will return to western areas later.
