Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
For Scotland, rain will continue to edge north, showers developing further south but also some brightness possible. Elsewhere, bright spells in the west but generally cloudy with heavy showers, these merging across southeastern England later. Windy at times, strong gusts near heavy showers.  
Tonight, mild but cloudy with further periods of heavy rain or showers for all areas. Becoming very windy across the south, southerly or southwesterly gales developing across southernmost counties later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Heavy showers for all on Thursday with strong winds or gales affecting southern and later northwestern. On Friday, becoming drier with some sunshine, the winds easing down.
