

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cold and often breezy conditions, with persistent heavy rain, for Wales, parts of the Midlands and western England, and later eastern Northern Ireland. Southeast England brighter, slightly warmer, and mostly dry. Remaining areas brighter but showery. Overnight rain or showers across the southern half of the UK, the rain heavy in places. Elsewhere largely dry, with just isolated light showers.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday heavy rain moving north to reach northern England, while brighter conditions with heavy showers follow across southern areas. Northern Ireland and Scotland sunny intervals and light showers. Monday light showers across the UK, until rain reaches the far south.
