Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
In Scotland, rain in northwest dying out from south, dry and brighter in southeast. Cloudy over Northern Ireland, with rain spreading from west by evening. After a cloudy and misty start, bright or sunny spells developing in England and Wales. Rain reaching far southwest later. Still windy, gales in the northwest. Warm, locally very warm to the north of hills.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rather cloudy on Thursday with patchy early rain, becoming brighter in southeast England. Mostly dry and quite sunny on Friday, though more cloudy over northern Scotland at first. Windy, local gales in north. Cooler on Friday, particularly towards the southeast.
