Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A fine day for many with long periods of sunshine, albeit hazy at times. Feeling very warm in most places, with generally light southerly winds. A band of rain, heavy at times, will reach Northern Ireland soon after midnight, and then spread to other western areas by morning, but it will stay dry with clear spells further east.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain spreading east on Tuesday, but turning patchier as it does, although possibly heavy in the south for a time. Probably staying dry, bright and warm in East Anglia until later. Cooler and brighter conditions will follow for Wednesday with blustery showers.
