Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
England and Wales will start generally cloudy and misty with a few spots of rain or drizzle. However, much sunnier skies, already across Northern Ireland and Scotland will spread southeastwards, reaching all but the far south of England by evening. It will feel less mild than of late in brisk northwesterly winds.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Apart from a few showers for northern Scotland, it will be dry throughout. There will be plenty of sunshine during the day, but with widespread frost and patchy fog overnight which may be slow to clear in places. It will be rather cold.
