Headline:

South-dry, localised frosts. North-milder, cloudier, heavier rain far north later.

This Evening and Tonight:

Clear spells, some frost S.Wales, S.England. Cloudier further north, patchy light rain and drizzle developing, heavier rain N.Scotland later.

Tuesday:

Rain spreading southeast, although SE.England staying dry and bright. Sunny intervals/showers following to Scotland/N.Ireland.

Outlook for Wednesday:

Unsettled - bands of occasionally heavy rain spreading southeast, then east, across the British Isles. Scattered blustery showers following, mainly to western areas. Becoming windy southwest England.
