

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 06 Jul 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Very wet across central England, Wales and parts of Northern England, with persistent heavy rain causing localised disruption due to flooding. Elsewhere mainly fine, but scattered heavy showers developing in southern England. Overnight, southern Scotland and southwest England will see the heaviest rain, with most other areas becoming dry. Becoming breezy central and northern areas for a time.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday, southern Scotland and southwest England staying wet, with Northern Ireland also seeing fairly persistent but lighter rain. Elsewhere, sunny spells and scattered heavy, perhaps thundery, showers. Remaining unsettled on Sunday, with further heavy or thundery showers for most, sometimes prolonged.
