Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A cold start with any fog in the south clearing during the morning. A fine day with sunny spells for most, but cloudier across Wales, southern and central England with the odd spot of rain. Feeling colder across northern parts. Mostly dry with patchy cloud overnight. Thicker cloud and some rain is likely in northwestern parts later.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Dry and bright for most at first on Friday. Thicker cloud and patchy drizzle in the south will slowly edge northwards. A narrowing rain band in the northwest will move south. Turning colder with scattered showers throughout Saturday after rain clears the southeast.
