Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Many places will start grey and misty with patchy fog, and a widespread frost. However, sunnier skies will edge westwards during the day, bringing a more cheerful feel as it should also become a little less cold. A few light showers are possible near northeastern coasts.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

It will remain mostly dry and cold with some decent spells of sunshine during the day. However, nights are likely to become very cold with widespread hard frosts along with a few freezing fog patches. Later Sunday, some rain may edge into some northern and western areas bringing the risk of icy surfaces.
