Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain will continue to move across the UK during the morning, clearing the east coast during the afternoon. Scattered, blustery and occasionally heavy showers will follow, spreading into northern and western parts. However, southern and eastern parts could become sunnier and drier for a time. An increasing wind will also lead to it feeling rather chilly.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Outbreaks of heavy rain will spread eastwards across the south during Wednesday, whilst showery outbreaks and brighter intervals will continue elsewhere. Thursday then remains unsettled, with scattered showers for all parts. It will also remain quite chilly, with a brisk westerly wind.
