Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will be dry with good sunny spells and overnight frost and local mist or fog patches. The fog may persist in a few places. Scotland will be more cloudy with outbreaks of rain or drizzle, chiefly in the west, followed by showers in the north. Generally light winds.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Scotland will be cold and windy with showers, wintry on hills, on Monday, but mostly dry and sunny on Tuesday. Elsewhere should be mostly dry, sunny in many places, perhaps more cloudy at times in the south. There may be a few showers on eastern coasts during Tuesday.
