

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 11 Jul 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Occasional rain or showers affect Scotland and Northern Ireland, whilst England and Wales see a mainly dry day with sunny spells. Further outbreaks of rain are expected into southwest England and Wales by the evening; this spreading east to give much of England some rain overnight. It'll be a dry and cool night across Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A cooler day with sunny spells for most, but scattered showers develop in northern parts. Occasional rain is expected to affect southeast England for much of the day. Bright for many on Tuesday, although outbreaks of rain spread in from the Southwest.
