Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Any early mist will clear to leave much of the UK dry and fine. Across England and Wales, sunny spells will develop and it will become very warm. Although coastal areas could see some mistiness linger. In the northwest it will be cooler with some cloud and patchy rain edging south. Staying largely clear overnight, although some mist returning.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Remaining dry and sunny, with a hot couple of days expected across southern and central England. Although some coastal areas will be cooler, as a refreshing breeze develops. Elsewhere, dry but cloudier conditions persist, although it will still be feeling warm.
