Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Central and northern areas much brighter than of late and less cold with sunny intervals, but some showers as well although most of these will be across northwestern areas. Fresh or strong west to southwest winds. In the south, bright for a time and only isolated showers but here becoming more cloudy with some rain spreading the far south.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Bright spells, but also some showers or longer spells of rain, occasionally heavy, and windy at times as well especially on Monday with a risk of gales which may be locally severe. Temperatures near normal but feeling colder in the wind.
