Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will start cloudy with some patchy light rain in western Scotland, Cumbria and perhaps Northern Ireland. This will spread to northern and eastern England during the afternoon with rain becoming less likely here, whilst clearing from Northern Ireland. Wales and southern and western parts will be largely cloud-free after any fog clears, becoming rather warm in the sunshine later.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

The weekend will be largely settled, dry, warm and sunny for most parts of the UK, but perhaps more in the way of cloud at times along southeastern coasts, spoiling the sunshine here. Winds freshening in the channel during Sunday.
