

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Monday 10 Mar 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
The northern half of the UK will have a mainly dry day with sunny spells after any early fog clears, with temperatures around normal. Further south, it will be cloudier and feel much cooler than on Sunday, especially in eastern areas. Overnight, fog patches will form in the north under clear skies, whilst cloud will persist across southern areas.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Early fog and cloud will lift and gradually break up to leave Tuesday dry for most with sunny spells. Remaining settled on Wednesday with a good deal of sunshine for most, and light winds. Mild by day but cold overnight.
