Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southeast England generally cloudy with light rain at times, though perhaps becoming drier and brighter later. Elsewhere, often dry with sunny spells, once patchy freezing fog in the north clears, but some wintry showers are likely, especially in the east. It will be cold and windy. A widespread frost tonight with showery rain, sleet or snow spreading to northern areas.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Showery outbreaks of rain, sleet or snow continuing southwards across England and Wales on Tuesday, with rain becoming more persistent and heavier later across Wales and the southwest. Wednesday, mostly dry and sunny, but rain at times for the south.
