Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a dry, sunny start in eastern Britain showers in the west will spread to all parts. The showers are likely to merge across England and Wales, giving longer spells of rain this evening. Showers in northern Britain will become wintry over higher ground. Gales or severe gales in many areas. Showers persisting in the west overnight. Feeling cold.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain spreading northeast across much of England and Wales during Monday. Drier, brighter across southern Scotland and Northern Ireland but wet and windy over northwest Scotland with some significant snow for higher hills. Bright spells and scattered showers on Tuesday.
