

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Thursday 10 May 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain in the north will gradually clear, followed by clearer intervals and scattered showers. A dry start elsewhere with rain or showers developing during the day. Rain will be heavy and persistent in the south with mist and low cloud, but it will clear overnight. Breezy and rather cold in the south, temperatures near normal elsewhere.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Scattered showers or longer periods of rain on Friday and Saturday. Some of the showers will be heavy at times with a risk of thunder, with the heaviest most persistent rain expected over Wales and the Southwest on Friday evening. Temperatures near normal.
