Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Any patchy fog in Scotland will clear, then there will be some sunshine, especially during this morning. Otherwise most places will have a cloudy or dull day, and outbreaks of rain across southeast England will move northwestwards, reaching southern Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland by evening. Drier weather will follow from the south, but still with a few coastal showers. It will feel cool under grey skies and in northeasterly breezes.  
Tonight, it will remain cloudy, damp and misty with patchy fog, and also a little rain or drizzle in places.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

A cloudy, damp start on Wednesday. However, a band of organised rain will move southeastwards later Wednesday and at first on Thursday with much brighter, mainly dry weather to follow with some sunshine.
