Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Central and southeast England will start with rain, sleet or snow, accompanied by northerly gales. However, these will clear eastwards during the morning. Thereafter, all areas will have sunny spells, but also a few wintry showers, these mainly near coasts. It will remain cold with a persistent frost for northern Scotland.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

There will be clear or sunny spells and many areas should remain generally dry. However, scattered wintry showers are likely, these mainly near northern and eastern coasts where a few may be heavy. There will be hard frosts night and morning, along with some patchy freezing fog.
