

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Very unsettled with rain or showers for most places. The heaviest showers, with the risk of thunder, hail and squally winds will affect southwest England, Wales and later, Northern Ireland. Tonight, the heaviest showers, perhaps with some torrential downpours, will move into southern England, as another area of rain affects eastern parts. Remaining mild.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Further very heavy showers possible on Friday across central and southern areas of England in particular, as more general rain affects North Sea coastal areas. However, Northern Ireland should become drier. By Saturday, further rain will affect the southeast, but northwestern parts should be largely fine.
