

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dense fog across southern England and Wales will gradually clear through the morning, but it will stay mostly cloudy with a few spots of rain. In contrast, Northern Ireland, northern England and Scotland will be sunnier but much colder, with showers and coastal gales affecting north-east Scotland.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Colder air will reach all by Wednesday, leading to a frosty start, however it will be fine and sunny, with a scattering of showers along eastern coasts. Cloud will thicken later across the north-west leading to a wetter and windier day for many on Thursday, away from the south where it'll stay fine.
